



EMT-Basic

Colorado Mountain College's EMT-Basic program provides specific training for those interested in working as emergency medical technicians in emergency situations. This program covers The Colorado Health Department's training requirements and prepares students for the National Registry examination and Colorado state certification. The semester long program consists of three classes totaling twelve credits and includes two days of clinical rotations and one day of field internship. Students who earn a "B" or better in both courses will receive a Colorado Mountain College Certificate of Occupational Proficiency and will be allowed to sit for the National Registry Exam.

◆ State Certification Fee	\$17.50 for background check - CBI only (certification is free)
◆ Uniform	Varies - college provides an EMS shirt and ID badge and student must provide blue uniform style pants, shine able black shoes, and belt

What information needs to be provided in order to register for the program?

- ⇒ Proof of being at least 18 years of age on or before the first day of class
- ⇒ Completed Colorado Mountain College Admissions Application
- ⇒ Proof of college level reading and composition (ACT or SAT scores, college transcripts, or Accuplacer testing at CMC)

What information needs to be provided within the first two weeks of class?

- ⇒ Successful background check and drug screen (Look for email instructions before class starts)
- ⇒ Immunization records including proof of MMR vaccinations (2 shots or titer)
- ⇒ Proof of 1 negative 2-step TB test or 1 Quantiferon gold or 1 chest x-ray within the past year (need 2 if going to St. Mary's)
- ⇒ Proof of 3 Hepatitis B vaccinations or titer or signed rejection
- ⇒ Proof of current season flu shot
- ⇒ Proof of varicella (chickenpox) vaccinations (2 shots or titer)
- ⇒ Copy of current AHA CPR for the Healthcare Provider certification (**this course is taught during the EMT Basic class**)
- ⇒ Copy of health insurance card
- ⇒ Signed Colorado Mountain College Waiver (instructor will provide)
- ⇒ Signed Worker's Compensation Form (instructor will provide)
- ⇒ Signed Functional Position Description for EMT (instructor will provide)
- ⇒ Signed Student Policy Manual (instructor will provide)
