CMC Tuition

Students must register for 6-9 credits through CMC:

Sustainability Studies students register for SUS 3910 "Field Experience in Sustainability" and SUS 3775 "Special Topics" with Dr. Langmaid. Business Administration students register for BUS 4075 "Special Topics" and MAN 4090 "Global Business" with Dr. Bell. Tuition is paid separately from the program fee.

Additional Student Costs

Not covered as part of the program fee, or tuition are items such as:

- Ground Transportation to and from Denver International Airport
- Airfare from Denver, CO to Bangkok, Thailand
- Any Optional Independent Travel after Bhutan
- Spending Money for Bhutan clothing, souvenirs, crafts, and art

My participation in this activity is conditional upon the following:

- 1. I agree to follow the laws of the destination country at all times while in-country.
- 2. I will not possess or use illegal drugs at any time during travel. I understand that this could have serious consequences, including lengthy incarceration, and that CMC, any partnering organizations, or the U.S. Government will not be able to assist me if I am arrested or detained for illegal drug use or possession.
- 3. I agree to register my travel details with the U.S. State Department Smart Traveler Program prior to departure (https://step.state.gov/step/).
- 4. I agree to carefully review all orientation materials provided by CMC, partnering organizations, and the destination country background and health information published by the U.S. State Department, U.S. Center for Disease Control (CDC), or other Federal agency. https://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/destinations/traveler/none/bhutan

- 5. I agree to adhere to all written and verbal instructions, rules, and expectations given by the course instructors, partnering organization instructors, administrators, and/or host families. Faculty and other members charged with leadership of the curriculum and activities while abroad may, for any reason in their sole judgment related to the safety, welfare or quality of the educational experience being offered, choose to remove a student at any time from a study abroad program. In the event this occurs, the student will be sent home at their own expense. Students will be responsible for any and all additional costs, travel arrangements, and other logistics associated with early removal from a study abroad program.
- 6. I agree to promptly provide all completed forms and documentation requested by the course instructor and/or partnering organization(s).

I understand that the program fee INCLUDES 17 nights of lodging in Bhutan, all meals and ground transportation in Bhutan, round trip flight from Bangkok Thailand to Paro Bhutan, all classes, presentations, visits to cultural sites and national parks while in Bhutan. I also understand the trip fee EXCLUDES ground transportation to Denver Airport, round trip airfare from Denver, CO to Bangkok Thailand, and CMC tuition.
- 8. I understand that travel delays and changes to the travel and course itineraries can occur at any time, and I agree that CMC and any partnering organizations are not responsible for any unexpected occurrences, inconveniences, or additional expenses that result from cancellation, delay, or itinerary changes. Political instability, environmental conditions, health emergencies, or other regional activities may affect the viability and safety of a trip, requiring immediate itinerary modification or cancellation at any time, including during the trip.
- 9. I understand that I am traveling to a region where climate, weather, food, water, accommodations, and political, legal, and cultural norms may be different from the United States and what I may be accustomed to. I will do my best to adjust my expectations and adapt to these differences in the spirit of learning and exploration.
- 10. I agree to participate fully in all course-related activities. I understand that full participation includes avoiding conduct during free time that may hinder my ability to focus and actively participate in course activities (i.e., get sufficient sleep and avoid excessive alcohol consumption, etc.).
- 11. I agree to maintain regular communication with the instructor, partnering organization instructors, and host families regarding concerns I may have about participation or activities.
- 12. I understand there will be very little free time while in Bhutan. I agree to abide by limitations to free time activities that will be established by our host host, Royal Thimpu College.
- 13. I understand there will be regular walking and hiking in high altitude mountain environments, and I have the physical fitness to participate in moderately strenuous hiking activities.
- 14. I will wear culturally appropriate Bhutanese clothing during organized learning sessions, and demonstrate respect and consideration for the course instructors, partnering organizations' employees and students, host families, other participants in the program, and citizens of Bhutan.
- 15. I understand and agree that failure to adhere to the terms of this agreement may result in the immediate termination of my participation in this program and that I may be sent home at my own expense.
